Swimming Pool Opening

We are pleased and excited to announce that our community pool will open May 29th 2010!! The pool season will be from May 29th, 2010 thru September 6th, 2010.

All of our residents are invited to get their free season pass. Only guests are required to pay for the use of our community pool. If you already have a pool pass please stop by the office to confirm you have the correct pool pass.

Pool passes may be obtained at our Leasing Office located at 201 I Street SW. The hours to purchase/ obtain the passes are 4:30pm till 5:30pm Wednesdays and Fridays. Please stop by the Leasing Office to pick up your pool pass applications beginning Friday May 21, 2010.

While DC public schools are open, pool hours will be Saturday and Sunday from 12pm to 8pm. The pool will be open on Monday, Memorial Day from 12pm to 8pm. Once schools are closed, the pool hours will be from 12:00pm to 8:00pm Tuesday to Sunday. The pool will be closed on Mondays.

Pool rules and regulations

The pool will be open Tuesday through Sunday from 12pm to 8pm. The pool will normally close every Monday. For the health and safety, welfare and enjoyment of all our residents and their guests, the following rules will be enforced:

- 1- Residents and /or guests admittance to the pool and or pool area is with a current Capitol Park Plaza Pool Pass issued by the Management Office.
- 2- Residents and /or guests under the age of 13 are not permitted in the pool or pool area unless accompanied and directly supervised by a resident, age 18 years or older, at all times.
- 3- Guests are limited to two (2) per apartment per day and must be accompanied by a resident 18 years or older, at all times. In the event of overcrowding guests may not be permitted on any given day, subject to discretion of the lifeguard. Guest passes can be purchased at the leasing office during normal business hours. Guest passes must be purchased by a resident that is 18 years or older. Guest must adhere to all rules and regulations. Residents will be held responsible for any damages or injuries, caused directly or indirectly, by their guests.
- 4- All bathers must shower before entering the pool.
- 5- Non-swimmers must remain in the shallow end of the pool. The water is not to exceed their mid-chest. Residents and guests under the age of 13 who have not passed the swim test cannot go beyond 3-foot depth.
- 6- The following are **prohibited** in the pool area:
 - (a). Alcoholic Beverages
 - (b). Chewing gum or chewing tobacco
 - (c). Persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol
 - (d). Spitting or blowing of the nose in the pool
 - (e). Glass, ceramic, pottery containers or sharp objects
 - (f). Nude or topless sunbathing.
 - (g). Speedos, Thongs, Cut offs or street clothes
 - (h). Running, pushing, wrestling, roughhousing
 - (i). Smoking
 - (j). Wheeled vehicles or toys (except strollers/ wheelchairs)
 - (k). Playing, swinging, or sitting on ladder
 - (l). Climbing, hanging, or playing on lifelines
 - (m). Diving or cannon-balling
 - (n). Foul or abusive language
 - (o). Sitting at the lifeguard table
 - (p).food
 - (q). Entering the filter room area
 - (r). Squirt Guns
 - (s). "Floaties" (no floatation devices)
 - (t). Radios (except when used w/headphones)
- 7- All personal belongings should be removed when exiting. Articles left behind will be disposed of.
- 8- Greaseless type's suntan lotion is to be used if you wish to use the pool.
- 9- No person with a communicable disease is allowed to use the pool.
- 10- The lifeguard, as an agent for Management, has full authority to collect guest passes, enforce rules, and to deny entry to guests and or residents due to overcrowded conditions, past incidents of rule violations or other due cause. The lifeguard has absolute authority to control or forbid the use of facemasks, snorkels, swim fins, life preservers, floaters, balls, or other play items.
- 11- The pool facility may be closed at the discretion of the head lifeguard and in accordance with the District of Columbia ordinance due to thunder, lightning, rain air temperature under 65 degrees or due to operational breakdown or other unhealthy conditions.
- 12- At the discretion of the lifeguard a rest period of 15 minutes may be observed every quarter before the swimming hour. Swimming during this period will be restricted to those swimmers 18 years of age and older. The only exception will be Residents and/or guests 5 years of age or younger that are being directly supervised in the water by a resident 18 years of age or older.
- 13- The "emergency signal" for clearing the pool is 3 blasts of the whistle. When the signal is sounded, all swimmers must leave the pool by the nearest ladder or pool edge.
- 14- All residents, by the act of accepting a pool pass for himself or any family member or for any guests accepts full responsibility for any injury or accident while using the pool facilities. The head of any household also accepts full responsibility for any paid guests to the pool facilities. Any person using the pool facilities agrees to hold harmless Capitol Park Plaza, Edgewood Management Corporation or its owners from any injury or accident while using the pool. All residents, by the act of accepting a pool pass for himself or any family member or for any guests accepts full responsibility for any injury or accident while using the pool facilities. The head of any household also accepts full responsibility for any paid guests to the pool facilities. Any person using the pool facilities agrees to hold harmless Capitol Park Plaza, Edgewood Management Corporation or its owners from any injury or accident while using the pool.

**Rules and Regulations Governing
Use of the Swimming Pool**

The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of all to assure safe and sanitary operations of the pool facilities. Your cooperation in abiding by these conditions will afford pleasant relations and recreation for all concerned. Residents and their families are requested to observe all rules and regulations and obey instructions of all employees.

- 1- All persons using the pool or pool areas do so at their own risk and sole responsibility. The management assumes no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use. Persons using the pool covenant and agree with the owners and management for and in consideration of the use of the pool as an added facility to make no claim against the owner or management for an account of any loss of personal property, except where such loss, injury or damage can be clearly proved to have resulted from and being proximately caused by the direct negligence of the leased premises or any portion of, or facility upon, the property of which the lease premises are a part.
- 2- The cost of the property damage will be charged to the responsible party.
- 3- The management will not be responsible for any loss or damage to personal property of any kind.
- 4- Members agree to save harmless the owner and management from any and all liabilities and actions or whatever nature by any members or guests growing out of the use of the swimming pool or pool area, except where such loss injury or damage can be clearly proved to have resulted from, agents, servants or employees, in the operations, care of or leased maintenance of the leased premises or any portion of or facility upon, the property of which the leased premises are a part.
- 5- Members will be admitted to the pool areas upon presentation of their pool pass to the attendant. Each family will be allowed two (2) guests at any one time, provided if, in the opinion of facility upon, the property of which the leased premises are a part.
Charges for guests are as follows:
Per day.....Adults \$4.00 and Children \$3.00
Passes must be purchased during regular business hours from 10:00am to 4:00pm
Saturday thru Friday **only**.
- 6- The pool may be closed at any time due to breakdown, weather or operational difficulties and or at the discretion of the pool manager or lifeguard on duty.
- 7- Members will be responsible for the actions of the children and guests accompanying them.
- 8- Members and guests may use the facilities with the understanding that they comply with all the rules and regulations promulgated by the municipality and management.
- 9- Pool identification cards are not transferable. If any identification card is lost a duplicate will be issued at "full cost of the remaining period". There will be no refund of pool membership fees should patron wish to "cancel" swimming pool membership.
- 10- Identification cards must be given to the guard when entering the pool area and will be retained until departure.
- 11- Identification cards can be revoked for misuse or for reasons of misconduct as determined by management.

- 12- Children under twelve (12) years of age must be accompanied by an adult to be admitted to the pool and must remain with the children the entire time they are in the pool area.
- 13- All persons must have a shower before entering the pool.
- 14- Greaseless type sun tan lotion must be used instead of "oil" type.
- 15- Absolutely no diving allowed.
- 16- Tubes, water wings, play equipment, etc., are strictly prohibited.
- 17- Running, pushing, wrestling, ball playing, or any undue disturbance in or about the pool area will not be tolerated.
- 18- No glass of any type will be permitted in the pool enclosures.
- 19- All trash must be deposited in receptacles.
- 20- Smoking will be allowed in the smoking area only.
- 21- No pets will be allowed in the pool area.
- 22- Admission will be denied to anyone with skin abrasions, colds, coughs, flamed eyes, infections or anyone wearing bandages.
- 23- Wheeled vehicles will not be allowed in the pool area. (However wheelchairs are accepted).
- 24- Robes and other suitable garments must be worn to and from the pool areas. Dripping bathing suits in the building must be avoided.
- 25- The use of intoxicants anywhere in the pool area is strictly prohibited. Persons under the influence of alcohol will not be permitted in the pool area.
- 26- Food may not be brought inside the pool area.
- 27- No abusive or profane language or breach of peace will be tolerated.
- 28- Only radios with headphones will be allowed.
- 29- First aid supplies may be obtained from the lifeguard.
- 30- Management reserves the right to refuse entry or deny pool privileges to anyone at its discretion. If you are a resident the above regulations become part of your lease.
- 31- These rules and regulations may be revised or amended at any time at the sole discretion of the management.
- 32- Failure to comply with any of the foregoing rules and regulations will results in the violator (s) being barred from using the pool facilities.
- 33- There will be a fifteen (15) minute rest period out of each hour for the children.
- 34- No street footwear will be permitted on the concrete apron of the pool areas.
- 35- Bath-house, shower and sanitary facilities are provided in the pool area.
